What is a whole body skin check?

A whole body skin check is a thorough check of the skin including spots, moles, blemishes, colourations, growths, etc. It allows doctor to check all areas of the body to determine if there are any areas for concern.

Why should I have a whole body skin check done?

Australia's skin cancer rates are one of the highest in the world. Statistics show that two in every three Australians will be diagnosed with skin cancer before they turn 70. Most people do not have the knowledge or experience to monitor changes in their skin or how to recognise skin cancer signs. How long does it take?

A whole body skin check can range from 15 minutes to 30 minutes, depending on skin type. Your visit will also include a blood pressure check and pulse reading.

How often should I have a whole body skin check done?

A whole body skin check should be conducted every 12 months to detect any changes in the skin. If you're concerned about any spots, moles, blemishes or colourations on your skin, contact us immediately for a skin check. If any areas of the skin need more frequent monitoring, we may put you on a 3 monthly recall list.

What equipment is used?
